

To Our Addolorata Villa Residents and Family Members:

Thank you for your continued support of the Addolorata Villa and the associates who are working so diligently with the COVID-19 infection prevention strategies to provide amazing care to your loved ones, our residents.

Throughout this crisis, we have kept you informed, as quickly as possible, with every confirmed case that has been diagnosed. This week there has been a cluster of COVID-19 activity limited ONLY to the first floor of the skilled nursing building and I would like to take this opportunity to update you on our current situation and discuss the continued measures that are being implemented.

Current Confirmed Cases:

There has been one associate with a reported positive COVID test result. This associate last worked on 4/22/2020 and became symptomatic on 4/23/2020. The associate was tested on 4/23/2020 and the positive COVID test result was reported to Addolorata Villa leadership on 4/27/2020. This associate works on the 1st floor where the two residents who also received positive test results over this past weekend reside.

Containment Procedures:

Residents continue to be monitored closely for the earliest signs or symptoms of COVID-19.

If any signs or symptoms develop, a resident is immediately isolated. Associates continue to be screened daily when they report for work; if any screening element is noted to be abnormal, the associate is sent home.

Precautionary Measures:

The skilled nursing unit has limited access to only staff assigned to that unit with no visitors allowed. Addolorata Villa continues to restrict visitors and monitors those associates and residents, following CDC-regulated standards for infection control and to prevent any spread of the virus. The staff continues to maintain proper PPE recommendations and protocol, as defined by the local and state health departments and the CDC.

Due to the guidelines we have in place for social distancing and prevention of the spread of the virus, it is important to note that these cases are considered isolated to the Skilled Nursing unit and there is no contact tracing to any other part of the campus. In our daily discussions with state and local health departments, we continue to follow all guidance regarding protection for our staff as well as the other residents.

We understand that this is a time of anxiety and unknowns for the safety of you or loved ones. 100% of our efforts are geared towards the safety of your loved ones.
