

To Our Addolorata Villa Residents and Family Members:

The associates continue to truly appreciate all of your support through this very difficult time. We were disappointed to only get back about 15 additional test results today from our widespread testing completed last week. My guess is that the lab is completely swamped with test kits, as the overall testing in the region has increased. Likely, we will obtain the remainder of the results tomorrow from the tests that were done last week.

Today, we tested 97 independent living residents as well as staff that work in Independent Living and Assisted Living. We again are very grateful to Dr. Leo Kanev for his gift of time and his compassion for our residents as he coordinated and helped to conduct the testing today.

Of the results received today, we did learn of two residents and two associates that have tested positive for the virus. We ask for your continued prayers for those residents and associates that are currently battling the virus.

Confirmed Cases to Report Today:

One resident was from Chapel View (Sheltered Care) and they are asymptomatic (no symptoms) and remain at Addolorata Villa. The second resident was an independent living resident who went to the hospital, was tested and confirmed positive. Of course, this is concerning to have a resident in Independent Living test positive. We are in the process of contact tracing for this case, as it will be important to understand if this resident has been out of the campus recently or what their contact was with others (both associates and residents) on campus.

The two associates who tested positive are from the healthcare center. They are both off work and under quarantine at this time.

Important to note: All of our prior reported prevention and containment procedures remain in place. Both floors of the skilled nursing are full PPE at this time (masks, face shields, gowns, gloves), so we essentially are treating all residents as if they are positive. At this time, the most important action we can take is to monitor everyone and treat for symptoms. Additionally, ALL of the infection prevention measures mentioned in previous memos remains in place.

Containment Procedures:

Residents continue to be monitored closely for the earliest signs or symptoms of COVID-19. If any signs or symptoms develop, a resident is immediately isolated. Associates continue to be screened daily when they report for work; if any screening element is noted to be abnormal, the associate is sent home. Additionally, we continue to test any staff member who has not already been tested.

Precautionary Measures:

Addolorata Villa continues to restrict visitors and monitors those associates and residents, following CDC-regulated standards for infection control and to prevent any spread of the virus. The staff continues to maintain proper PPE recommendations and protocol, as defined by the local and state health departments and the CDC.

We understand that this is a time of anxiety and unknowns for the safety of you or your loved ones. 100% of our efforts are dedicated towards the safety of your loved ones.
