

To Our Addolorata Villa Residents and Family Members:

Hoping you each had a very special Mother's Day under these extraordinary circumstances. There have been no new resident cases of Covid-19 to report over the weekend. However, today we had a plant operations associate report they tested positive for the virus.

Confirmed Cases Today:

Confirmed Associate Case:

This associate, a plant operations associate, last worked on 5/08/2020. They began exhibiting symptoms on 5/08/2020. The associate was tested for COVID-19 on 5/09/2020 and on 5/10/2020 the test yielded a positive result for the virus.

Important to note: All of our prior reported containment procedures remain in place. IDPH nurses have not come on site yet to test all the residents (except independent living) but we remain hopeful that they will be on campus soon. At this time, the most important action we can take is to monitor everyone and treat for symptoms. Additionally, ALL of the infection prevention measures mentioned in previous memos remains in place.

Containment Procedures:

Residents continue to be monitored closely for the earliest signs or symptoms of COVID-19. **If any signs or symptoms develop, a resident is immediately isolated.** Associates continue to be screened daily when they report for work; if any screening element is noted to be abnormal, the associate is sent home.

Precautionary Measures:

Addolorata Villa continues to restrict visitors and monitors those associates and residents, following CDC-regulated standards for infection control and to prevent any spread of the virus. The staff continues to maintain proper PPE recommendations and protocol, as defined by the local and state health departments and the CDC.

We understand that this is a time of anxiety and unknowns for the safety of you or your loved ones. 100% of our efforts are dedicated towards the safety of your loved ones.
