



To Our Addolorata Villa Residents and Family Members:

There have been no new resident cases of COVID-19 to report over the weekend. However, today we had a dining associate report that they tested positive for the virus. Additionally, we would ask for your prayers for those residents and associates that are currently battling the virus.

Confirmed Associate Case Today:

This associate, a dining associate, last worked on 5/01/2020. They began exhibiting symptoms on 5/05/2020 and went to get tested for COVID-19 on that date. The results yielded a positive result, which was reported on 5/11/2020. This associate did not have direct resident contact while at work on the campus.

Important to note: We continue await the IDPH nurses to come on site to complete the widespread testing that I have mentioned in several of my recent memos. We are literally at the mercy of others to get this completed, but remain hopeful that they will be on campus soon. It remains our intention to get 100% of staff and all residents on campus (EXCEPT independent living residents). All of our prior reported containment procedures remain in place. At this time, the most important action we can take is to monitor everyone and treat for symptoms. Additionally, ALL of the infection prevention measures mentioned in previous memos remains in place.

Containment Procedures:

Residents continue to be monitored closely for the earliest signs or symptoms of COVID-19. **If any signs or symptoms develop, a resident is immediately isolated.** Associates continue to be screened daily when they report for work; if any screening element is noted to be abnormal, the associate is sent home.

Precautionary Measures:

Addolorata Villa continues to restrict visitors and monitors those associates and residents, following CDC-regulated standards for infection control and to prevent any spread of the virus. The staff continues to maintain proper PPE recommendations and protocol, as defined by the local and state health departments and the CDC.

We understand that this is a time of anxiety and unknowns for the safety of you or your loved ones. 100% of our efforts are dedicated towards the safety of your loved ones.
