



To Our Addolorata Villa Residents and Family Members:

We were successful in testing over 250 residents and staff members over the past three days. Heartfelt thanks to our Medical Director, Dr. Leo Kanev, who assisted us with all the testing. His gift of time is appreciated beyond words. Our expanded testing included AL, Ancora (Memory Support), Aspen, Chapel View and the Healthcare Center. With the widespread testing, we anticipate that most of the results will come in later this weekend or early next week. We did receive back our first eleven (11) results of residents/staff and they were all negative.

Today we had two additional residents in skilled nursing test positive and three associates who reported positive test results (separate from the widespread testing we did). We ask for your continued prayers for those residents and associates that are currently battling the virus.

Current Resident Confirmed Cases:

Resident #1:

This skilled nursing resident began exhibiting symptoms on 5/9/2020. They were tested for COVID-19 at the hospital on 5/14/2020, after exhibiting fever, oxygen desaturation, lethargy and pneumonia. The results yielded a positive result on 5/15/2020.

Resident #2:

This resident was a long-term care resident and had been tested for COVID-19, due to exhibiting symptoms. Results were obtained on 5/14/2020 which yielded a positive result for the virus.

Current Associate Confirmed Cases:

Associate #1:

This associate, a CNA, last worked on 5/10/2020. They began exhibiting symptoms on 5/11/20. They were tested for COVID-19 on 5/13/2020, which yielded a positive result for the the virus on 5/15/2020.

Associate #2:

This associate, a housekeeping associate, last worked on 5/13/2020 and began exhibiting symptoms on that same date. The results were reported to management on 5/14/2020.

Associate #3:

This associate, a Registered Nurse in the Health Care Center, last worked on 5/11/2020. They began exhibiting symptoms on 5/12/2020. On 5/13/2020 results yielded a positive result for the virus, which was communicated to management on 5/14/2020.

Important to note: All of our prior reported prevention and containment procedures remain in place. Both floors of the skilled nursing are full PPE at this time (masks, face shields, gowns, gloves), so we essentially are treating all residents as if they are positive. At this time, the most important action we can take is to monitor everyone and treat for symptoms.

Containment Procedures:

Residents continue to be monitored closely for the earliest signs or symptoms of COVID-19. If any signs or symptoms develop, a resident is immediately isolated. Associates continue to be screened daily when they report for work; if any screening element is noted to be abnormal, the associate is sent home.

Precautionary Measures:

Addolorata Villa continues to restrict visitors and monitors those associates and residents, following CDC-regulated standards for infection control and to prevent any spread of the virus. The staff continues to maintain proper PPE recommendations and protocol, as defined by the local and state health departments and the CDC.

We understand that this is a time of anxiety and unknowns for the safety of you or your loved ones. 100% of our efforts are dedicated towards the safety of your loved ones.
