

To Our Village of Victory Lakes Residents and Family Members:

I hope that you are all staying safe in this summer heatwave we are experiencing. As always, I want to thank you for your words of support as we continue our infection prevention protocols to ensure the safety of our residents, family members and associates. They are very much appreciated by the Village of Victory Lakes associates and residents. As you may be aware, we are conducting weekly COVID screening testing of Village of Victory Lakes Healthcare associates and have periodic widespread screening of residents in healthcare. We learned today, 7/26/2020, one resident in our healthcare center has tested positive for the virus.

Confirmed Resident Case:

This resident was previously tested on 7/10/2020 and 7/16/2020 which yielded a negative result for the virus. They were also part of a widespread screening at Victory Lakes which took place on 7/22/2020 (results are pending on this particular test). On 7/24/2020, this resident was admitted to the hospital with a condition not typically related to COVID. All admissions to a hospital are screened and this resident tested positive for COVID-19 and the result was reported to us today, 7/26/2020. This resident remains at the hospital in isolation.

Containment Procedures:

Residents continue to be monitored closely for the earliest signs or symptoms of COVID-19. **If any signs or symptoms develop, a resident is immediately isolated.** Associates continue to be screened daily when they report for work; if any screening element is noted to be abnormal, the associate is sent home. **We have no additional residents or associates who are exhibiting any signs of infection at this time.** As a reminder, all associates wear a mask while they are working to minimize any potential spread of the virus.

Precautionary Measures:

The Village at Victory Lakes continues to restrict visitors and monitors associates and residents, following CDC-regulated standards for infection control and to prevent any spread of the virus. The staff continues to maintain proper PPE recommendations and protocol, as defined by the local and state health departments and the CDC.

We understand that this is a time of anxiety and unknowns for the safety of you or loved ones. 100% of our efforts are geared towards the safety of your loved ones.
