

To Our Marian Village Residents and Family Members:

Throughout this crisis we have kept you informed, as quickly as possible, with every confirmed COVID-19 case that has been diagnosed. As you know, we are continuing with weekly widespread testing in of COVID-19. On 11/23/2020, a total of 89 tests were conducted (24 residents and 65 staff members). We have received the screening results and have learned that one new associate has tested positive for the virus.

Confirmed Associate Case:

This associate, a non-direct care associate has tested positive for the virus. They remain in quarantine at home and, per the CDC guidelines, can return to work in 14 days if they are free of symptoms.

Containment Procedures:

Residents will continue to be monitored closely for the earliest signs or symptoms of COVID-19. **If any signs or symptoms develop, a resident is immediately isolated.** Associates continue to be screened daily when they report for work; if any screening element is noted to be abnormal, the associate is sent home. **We have no additional residents or associates who are exhibiting any signs of infection at this time.** As a reminder, all associates wear a mask while they are working to minimize any potential spread of the virus.

Precautionary Measures:

Marian Village continues to monitor associates and residents, following CDC-regulated standards for infection control and to prevent any spread of the virus. The staff continues to maintain proper PPE recommendations and protocol, as defined by the local and state health departments and the CDC.

We understand that this is a time of anxiety and unknowns for the safety of you or your loved ones. 100% of our efforts are geared towards the safety of your loved ones.
