

To Our Village of Victory Lakes Residents and Family Members:

Throughout this pandemic we have kept you informed of every confirmed Covid-19 case that has been diagnosed on our campus. As you are aware, we are conducting serial widespread testing on a weekly basis for those areas of the campus considered the highest risk (assisted living and skilled nursing). We also continue to take precautionary measures to ensure the highest of safety and health levels for our residents and associates. On 11/3/2020 we were notified that one resident has tested positive for the virus. This individual was not part of a serial weekly widespread testing.

Confirmed Resident Case:

This resident, a Healthcare Center resident, was admitted to the hospital for a procedure and, per hospital protocol, was tested for COVID-19. The test yielded a positive result for the virus. They remain at the hospital in isolation.

Confirmed Associate Case:

This associate, a non-direct care worker, was symptomatic and was administered an onsite rapid test which yielded a positive result for the virus. This associate remains in isolation at home. Per the CDC guidelines, the associate can return to work in 10 days if she/he is free of symptoms.

Containment Procedures:

Due to the increase in positive cases throughout the United States and in Illinois, both the Governor and the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) have required us to suspend indoor visitation, communal dining, Salon Services and Life Enrichment activities for the assisted living and skilled nursing areas of the campus. **Outdoor visitation is still allowed, weather permitting.** Residents will continue to be monitored closely for the earliest signs or symptoms of COVID-19. **If any signs or symptoms develop, a resident is immediately isolated.** Associates continue to be screened daily when they report for work; if any screening element is noted to be abnormal, the associate is sent home. As a reminder, all associates wear a mask while working to minimize any virus's potential spread.

Precautionary Measures:

The Village at Victory Lakes continues to monitor associates and residents, following CDC-regulated standards for infection control and to prevent any spread of the virus. The staff continues to maintain proper PPE recommendations and protocol, as defined by the local and state health departments and the CDC.

We understand that this is a time of anxiety and unknowns for the safety of you or loved ones. 100% of our efforts are geared towards the safety of your loved ones.
